Omaha, Neb. – ECI Investment Advisors, Inc. is pleased to announce that Midtown Crossing at Turner Park, a \$350 million mixed-use urban development, was awarded the 2010 CREW Development of the Year award.

Built around an expanded and revitalized Turner Park, the million-square-foot development is anchored by a 5-screen “dine-in” Marcus Theatre, a 132-suite Westin element Hotel, a 33,000sf Prairie Life Fitness club and a 16,000sf urban grocery store (Wohlner’s Midtown Market and Deli). The project also includes nearly 500 condominiums and apartment units as well as more than 220,000 square feet of retail along with parking for more than 3,000 vehicles.

ECI was selected as the Master Developer for the project in 2005 by Mutual of Omaha Insurance Company after a nationwide search and interviews of qualified development firms. Construction will be completed at the end of 2010, culminating with the grand opening of the new Westin hotel.
